Note: Students may be dropped from the Success Center Program for non-attendance, non-completion of coursework, and chronic behavioral problems, and/or failure to follow Tulsa Tech policies.

Credit Recovery Policy

The below named student and/or parent understands the Success Center program is an alternative education opportunity for the student. The student's continued enrollment in the program is conditional upon regular and punctual attendance, satisfactory progress in the course attempted, good attitude, and continual compliance with acceptable student behavior and Tulsa Tech policies.

Student Conduct

Students are expected to be courteous and respectful toward fellow students, school personnel, and visitors to our school. Students are also expected to follow the Tulsa Tech policies for student behavior and smoking.

Plagiarism/Cheating

Initials Students shall not plagia

Students shall not plagiarize works found on the Internet or any other electronic resource. Plagiarizing is presenting the ideas or writings of others as one's own. Any act of cheating will be considered a serious violation. A warning will be given to the student and a behavioral contract will be mandatory. Any repeat of plagiarism/cheating will result in the student being dropped.

Phones/Electronic Devices

Use of a wireless telecommunication device or any other electronic resource device (MP3 player, IPod, Cell Phone, etc.) is strictly prohibited during class time. Students should refrain from bringing such devices to the Success Center. If observed using such a device while in the classroom, the student will receive one (1) warning to put the device away. The second incident will result in the device being taken up by the staff member and returned upon their leaving the premises. Any continued violations may result in the student being dropped.

Attendance

Initials

Regular attendance at the Success Center is imperative. Excessive absences will result in being dropped from the course. Each student must attend a minimum of 4 hours each week. Excessive absence may result in being placed on probation and will require a parent/student conference before resuming the program. Continued lack of attendance will result in being dropped.

Transportation

Student/parent is responsible for providing transportation. Each Success Center closes promptly at 8pm (Sept - May), 4pm (June & July). All students must be picked up by their ride in a timely manner. Failure by parents to pick their student up in a timely fashion may result in their child being dropped.

Coursework/Grading

Instruction is primarily internet-based with some off-line activities and projects. Questions regarding grades and grading policies can be addressed with the instructor.

Student Progress

Failure to complete assigned credit(s) in the designated time period will result in the student's loss of credit.

Special Services

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian or student to notify the Success Center counselor if accommodations are received at the sending high school.

Smoking

State law prohibits both smoking or possession of any tobacco products on the school grounds of any Tulsa Tech campus

Tuition/Fees

All credit recovery/accural semester course fees are: \$45.00.

Refunds/Withdrawal/Loss of Credit

Students cannot receive a refund once they have enrolled in the Success Center.
