# Pathways Scholarship

## Application Guidelines

Tulsa Tech makes scholarships available to students needing financial assistance in order to complete their career major. Applicants must meet specific scholarship criteria in order to be eligible. Scholarships are awarded on a first come first served basis.

This scholarship may be awarded to populations including individuals:

1. who have primarily been homemakers and have become separated, divorced, widowed, or whose spouse has become disabled,
2. single, pregnant women and single parents who are not married but who have custody of a child or children,
3. students who desire to work in occupations that are non-traditional for their gender, or
4. students representing diverse populations.

### Eligibility Criteria

1. Enroll in an eligible career major that meets at least 15 hours per week with no breaks in enrollment.
2. Submit a scholarship application within two weeks of the designated start date of the program.
3. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

### Renewal Requirements

1. Submit an application each year.
2. Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress as defined in the applicable instructors' syllabi throughout the duration of the scholarship.
3. Progress at a pace that will enable completion of the career major in the length of time specified in the school catalog.
4. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
