Provide personal, social service and educational intake assessment at each Success Center to determine an individual's interests and abilities. Career counselors and certified teachers assist with strengthening academic skills, assessing career interests for learning and employment success.

Operate year-round, late afternoon and evening computerized learning centers at five Tulsa Tech sites strategically located throughout Tulsa County.
