Admissions Checklist to Apply for Tulsa Tech

To apply for the PN, Rad Tech, or Surg Tech full-time program, complete the following:

## Academic Points *You must have a minimum of 5 points for Math and 5 points for Reading*

- ☐ **Academic Preparedness (40 points)**

Schedule an admissions test. Testing is offered in the Assessment Center at the Client Service Center on the Lemley Memorial Campus at 3638 S. Memorial Drive in Tulsa. Photo ID is required. Testing by appointment only. Testing fee is \$60.

- ☐ **Program Prerequisites**

- » Admission to Practical Nursing requires proof of Nurse Aide Certification from the Oklahoma Nurse Aide Registry.
- » Radiologic Technologist applicants must submit official college transcript(s) to the Admissions Office. Applicants with an associate's degree or higher will be given preference for admission.

- ☐ **Financial Aid**

**Who** Applicants to Practical Nursing, Radiologic Technologist, and Surgical Technology (ACT or SAT scores taken within the last 5 years may be submitted in lieu of testing).

**When** The HESI A2 Test is administered **by appointment only**.  
The non-refundable test fee for the HESI A2 is \$60; Schedule a test online at [www.registerblast.com/tulsatech](http://www.registerblast.com/tulsatech).

## Before You Test

- » Bring a valid government-issued photo ID
- » HESI test sessions may last up to three hours
- » NO outside calculators are permitted; HESI has an on-screen calculator built into the test
- » Test scores are available immediately upon completion of the test
- » The HESI A2 test may be taken twice between January - June and twice between July - December

## HESI A2 Registration Process

1. Have a current admissions application on file prior to scheduling the HESI test date.
2. Schedule and pay for the test online at [registerblast.com/tulsatech](http://registerblast.com/tulsatech). If you do not attend your scheduled test date, you will have to re-register and pay again.  
Seating for the test is limited; do not wait until the end of the application period to schedule your HESI A2 exam as allotted testing slots may already be taken.
3. Have a valid email address, which is required to create an Evolve account on the day of the test.

## HESI A2 Admissions Test

### Scores are good for three years

The HESI A2 is a computerized test published by Evolve. Applicants will have 3 hours to complete the exam. The HESI subtest areas that are administered by Tulsa Tech include:

- » **Reading Comprehension** (55 questions)—Assesses comprehension skills, such as identifying main ideas, finding the meaning of words in context, making inferences, and identifying key and supporting details
- » **Vocabulary and General Knowledge** (55 questions)—Assesses knowledge of basic vocabulary terms that are commonly used in both general English speaking and in the health care fields
- » **Mathematics** (55 questions)—Assesses math skills needed for health care fields, such as basic numeric operations, fractions, decimals, ratios and proportions, household measures, and general algebra skills

You must achieve a minimum of 70 percent each in Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary, and Mathematics. All subject areas must be taken in one session. Applicants will be ranked by total admission points.

## Program Prerequisites

Admission to Practical Nursing requires proof of Nurse Aide Certification from the Oklahoma Nurse Aide Registry.

Radiologic Technologist applicants must submit official college transcript(s) to the Admissions Office. The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) requires candidates for certification to have earned an associate (or more advanced) degree from an institution accredited or recognized by the ARRT. Applicants with an associate's degree or higher will be given preference for admission. Applicants who have college credit hours but not a degree will be given consideration for admission by total college credit hours earned.
